The Epilogue—Segment 5

Refine Your Salvation

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Halleluyah. What a mighty kesha tonight. The Book of Revelation chapter 6 verse 7: I want to talk about the visitation of the Pale Horse, "When the Lamb opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature say, 'Come!' I looked and there before me was a pale horse! Its rider was named Death, and Hades was following close behind him. They were given power over a fourth of the earth to kill by the sword, famine, and plague and by the wild beasts of the earth."

Precious people you see that when the fourth seal is opened and the fourth horse is released, the fourth and final of the first 4 horses, then you see that death befalls the earth. And in verse 9 "When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God and the testimony they had maintained." And you see that when the fourth seal is opened death and darkness befalls the earth even as the Lord showed me in that vision of the 29th of July 2009 the darkness that I saw befall the earth is because the church that is the light of the world; the church which is the light of the world has been taken away in the rapture of the church.

And that's why I want you to understand the timing that the Lord is presenting before you now; that means and can only mean that the church is sitting at the brinks of the rapture. And that's why it's very, very critical for all Christians who would want to enter the Kingdom of God to prepare instantly; to prepare for the coming of the Lord in the rapture.

The word pale, pale horse, the word pale it normally comes from a sickly, sickly appearance, sickly. Most of it is anemic; less blood, sick. And you see in the Book of <u>Jeremiah 21 verse 9</u> the Lord explains why He brings the sword, famine and plague. And that is a horrendous death that will consume more than one quarter of the earth. And the reason the Lord normally brings this plague, famine and sword at the same time is because of the rebellion of the hearts of men; even in <u>Jeremiah chapter 27 verse 13</u>; even in <u>Jeremiah chapter 29 verses 17 to 19</u>.

Let us turn to <u>Jeremiah chapter 21 verse 9</u>, again <u>Jeremiah 29</u> and we see how the Lord brings the plague, the famine and the sword and why. <u>Jeremiah 21 verse 9</u> He was talking about the rejection of Zedekiah's request because of the rebellion of the hearts of the people at the time and you see judgment had befallen the house of Jacob because of the rebellion of their hearts; and the same God you serve as a church—only that this now happens during the apocalypse. Whoever repents enters into the Wedding of the Lamb and does not have to face this horrendous death and massacre that befalls the earth, <u>verse 9 of Jeremiah 21</u>, "Whoever stays in this city will die by the sword, famine or plague." And he says "But whoever goes out and surrenders to the Babylonians who are besieging you will live; he will escape with his life"

The God of Heaven brought this judgment because of the rebellions of the hearts of the people that they refused to listen to the prophetic word of Jeremiah to repent. <u>Jeremiah chapter 27 verse 13</u>, I am just going through the Bible so you may see the instances where the Lord brought the sword, the famine, the plague.

Jeremiah chapter 27 verse 13, this is what He says, "Why will you and your people die by the sword, famine and plague with which the LORD has threatened any nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?" There was a controversy between the Lord and the house of Jacob and that's why the Lord pronounced and prescribed the sword, famine and plague and the stiff-neckedness of the house of Jacob refusing to repent. And so the Lord persistently promised this in the Book of Jeremiah. And you see again He is promising that when the pale horse comes down to the church; comes to the earth, the pale horse will bring forth horrendous suffering and death—death by the sword, by famine, by plague and also by the wild beasts of the earth.

Jeremiah chapter 29 verses 17 to 19 He promises the same thing. And He says "...yes, this is what the LORD Almighty says: 'I will send the sword, famine and plague against them and I will make them like poor figs that are so bad they cannot be eaten. I will pursue them with the sword, famine and plague and will make them abhorrent to all the kingdoms of the earth and an object of cursing and horror, of scorn and reproach, among all the nations where I drive them. For they have not listened to my words,' declares the LORD, 'words that I sent to them again and again by my servants the prophets."

So you see the controversy why God is able to send the sword, famine, plague because of the failure to listen to the Word of God, even the messages of God—essentially the failure to repent. Right now there is an ample opportunity for the church to repent and walk in the fear of the Lord and see the rapture of the church. But those that will not repent, those with rebellious hearts, the same God who sent rebellious Israel the plague, the sword, and famine will send it during the time that He releases the Pale Horse. And you see that the LORD does this consistently because He is the LORD.

The Book of <u>Matthew chapter 24 verse 7</u>, the Lord speaks about the same horrendous pain; <u>Matthew 24 verse 7</u> precious people, Halleluyah. And He says, "*Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places.*" The horrendous famine He talks about; even the Global Economic Crisis that I prophesied here that is biting right now, it is just a preamble, an introduction to the horrendous Economic Crisis that takes place after the church has been raptured.

And that is the reason now the antichrist will be needed, he will rise to power quickly because many people will look for somebody who can take authority and save their jobs. And you see very clearly that right now the Lord is pleading with the church to repent and like it was during the time of Noah and enter when that day arrives because on that day the door will be closed. And it's very critical that the church makes it into the Wedding of the Lamb because the church is meant for the Kingdom of God.

You have heard and seen all the things prophesied here come to pass; what will you tell the Lord? What excuse will you have before the Lord and listen to <u>Daniel chapter 9 verse 13</u>, <u>13 to 15</u>; again <u>Daniel chapter 9 verses 13 to 15</u>, "Just as it is written in the Law of Moses, all this disaster has come upon us, yet we have not sought the favor of the LORD our God by turning from our sins and giving attention to your truth. The LORD did not hesitate to bring the disaster upon us, for the LORD our God is righteous in everything he does; yet we have not obeyed him."

God is always righteous and He always gives the people a chance to repent and to avert the disaster. Now He has given Kenya and all the nations of the earth the chance to repent and prepare for the Coming of the Messiah. But if they don't repent, for those who will not repent in the church, they will not be able to

enter because God is holy and He cannot change the standard of holiness; He is righteous, and He cannot change the standard of righteousness. And that is why He will inevitably bring up the disasters that come with the Pale Horse.

Today's conversation in this broadcast is a testimony of the fact that God always gives people a chance to all people to repent and nobody can say they were not given a chance to repent. And God is always faithful; for those who are able to repent He is always faithful to them. And I am reading from the Book of <u>Daniel chapter 12</u> beginning from <u>verse 4 on</u>, <u>verse 1 to verse 3</u> talks about the Wedding of the Lamb. And then you see even what happens after then, "But you, Daniel, close up and seal the words of the scroll until the time of the end. Many will go here and there to increase knowledge. Then, I Daniel, looked and there before me stood two others, one on this bank of the river and one on the opposite bank. One of them said to the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, 'How long will it be before these astonishing things are fulfilled?' The man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, lifted his right hand and his left hand toward Heaven, and I heard him swear by him who lives forever, saying, 'It will be for a time, times and half a time." And he says, "When the power of the holy people has been finally broken, all these things will be completed."

What does that mean? That means the power of the church and that is the Holy Spirit and we know that when the rapture takes place, the church is taken up and the Holy Spirit is taken away. And so that is when the Pale Horse will bring his full effect on the earth. It is very, very critical for the church to understand this; it is very, very important for the church to understand that when the Holy Spirit has been taken away everything will break loose because in the Book of <u>2 Thessalonians chapter 2</u> we see very clearly that he that holds the antichrist back will (withhold) him until the time when finally the church has been taken and then the antichrist will be revealed. But He that holds the antichrist is the Holy Spirit.

If there is any Christian that is listening to me right now, you surely don't want to enter into this horrendous dispensation of the Pale Horse. Jesus preached about hell and Heaven. But the reason He preached about hell is that people may know how horrendous hell is; that they may do everything to avoid going to hell. And now He has allowed me to see the darkness that befalls the earth when the Pale Horse comes that you may avoid entering into the tribulation. The Book of Revelation chapter 13 talks about the activity of the antichrist after rapture; and the Book of Revelation chapter 20 also talks about what happens after rapture.

I am reading Revelation chapter 20 verses 1 to verse 6 " 1 And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the keys to the Abyss and holding in his hand a great chain. 2 He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil, or Satan, and he bound him for a thousand years. 3 He threw him into the Abyss, and locked and sealed it over him, to keep him from deceiving the nations anymore until the thousand years were ended. After that, he must be set free for a short time." Revelation chapter 20 verse 4, " 4 I saw thrones on which were seated those who had been given authority to judge. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony about Jesus and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years. 5 (The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended.) This is the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection." And he says, "The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years."

But I want you to focus on one thing here, he said, "And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony for Jesus." You don't want to go into the tribulation because if you will try to preach Jesus of Nazareth at that time you will be beheaded to complete the Word in the Bible. May those who have ears listen even as the Lord has spoken! Hasn't the Lord spoken with this nation? Hasn't the Lord spoken with this nation? May those who have ears listen! Yesu Mwana Kondoo!
